


### Teacher Feedback Analysis Report: Academic Year 2019-2020

Question 1: The Classrooms/Tutorial Rooms have necessary facilities and atmosphere which help in Teaching.

Ratings: 5 (30.8%), 4 (46.2%), 3 (23.1%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (30.8%), 4 (46.2%), 3 (23.1%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (38.5%), 4 (61.5%), 3 (0%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (38.5%), 4 (61.5%), 3 (0%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (38.5%), 4 (46.2%), 3 (15.4%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (53.8%), 4 (30.8%), 3 (15.4%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (7.7%), 4 (92.3%), 3 (0%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)





Ratings: 5 (38.5%), 4 (61.5%), 3 (0%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)




Analysis: The security infrastructure received strong positive feedback, with no negative ratings. The active and prompt nature of security services is well-regarded by the faculty.

Ratings: 5 (61.5%), 4 (23.1%), 3 (15.4%), 2 (0%), 1 (0%)




