Purpose:

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a collaborative relationship between IEMS and The College in order to enhance academic quality, skill development, research, employability, and higher education awareness among students and faculty.

Scope of Collaboration

Role of IEMS	Role of the Institute
1. Student Development Programmes IEMS will organize and conduct various Student Development Programmes (SDP's) . These may include soft skills development, personality enhancement, leadership training, and sessions to improve students' communication, confidence, and overall professional readiness.	The institute will propose the SDP requirements and the necessary in house arrangements will be taken care by the institutes
2. Faculty Development Programmes IEMS will offer Faculty Development Programmes (FDP's) aimed at upskilling teaching faculty in modern teaching practices, research methodology, curriculum innovation, and other key academic areas.	The institute has to provide the necessary infrastructure and correspondence in organizing and inviting the resource persons and the guests for the program

3. Assistance in Research Paper Writing IEMS shall assist interested faculty members of The College in writing and publishing research papers. This support will include guidance on research design, writing techniques, review processes, and selection of reputable journals.	The institute has to identify the research scholars and researchers for the program, the research output should acknowledge the host institute or publish the collaborative publication, can utilize the IEMS journal for publication.
4. Conduct of Job Mela IEMS will coordinate with the College to organize JobMela (Job Fairs) for final-year students. These events will invite companies from various sectors to offer placement and internship opportunities to students.	The institute has to depute staff and students to participate in the event. The necessary arrangements will be taken care by the host institute.
5. Career Guidance and MBA Awareness Programmes IEMS will conduct Career Guidance and MBA Awareness Programmes to educate students about the importance and opportunities of pursuing an MBA. Sessions will include discussions on career paths, MBA entrance preparation, industry trends, and scope of management education.	The host institute has to provide the necessary arrangements for addressing the students and the hospitality of the resource persons during the sessions
6. Job-Oriented Certification Programmes IEMS will offer job-oriented certification programmes in areas such as digital marketing, business analytics, soft skills, finance, entrepreneurship, and more. These will be made available to students of the College at a nominal cost, to ensure affordability and accessibility.	Both the parties have to decide the required courses for the certification. The participants have pay and register for the programme offered. The certificate will carry the signature of both head of the institutes.

Operational Framework

1. Both institutions will nominate coordinators to oversee the planning and execution of the collaborative activities.
2. Activities will be scheduled based on mutual convenience and academic calendars.
3. Any financial implications (if applicable) will be agreed upon beforehand.
4. Validity and Termination
5. This MoU will remain in force for a period of three (3) years from the date of signing and may be extended by mutual consent. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing a 30-day written notice.

General Terms

1. This MoU is a non-binding understanding and does not create legal or financial obligations unless mutually agreed in writing.
2. Both parties commit to maintaining a spirit of collaboration and mutual benefit throughout the duration of this MoU.
